Being a Christian in middle or high school can feel really lonely sometimes. That's why we believe being part of a Christ-Centered Community is so important. It reminds us that we aren't alone, and it also:

- Challenges us to grow more like Jesus (Hebrews 10:24-25)
- Encourages and supports one another (Galatians 6:2)
- Helps us discover and use our God-given gifts (Romans 12:4-8)
- Builds up our faith (James 5:13-16, 19-20)

- Fosters love and forgiveness (Colossians 3:13-14)
- Helps us grow together spiritually (1 Corinthians 14:26)

# WEDNESDAY NIGHT'S

EVERY WEDNESDAY, 7:00 PM – 8:45 PM

Every Wednesday, our middle and high school students (grades 6-12) come together for games, a message, small group time, and opportunities to connect with friends and grow in their faith.

## *ELEMENTS OF OUR MEETING*

Each Wednesday night has four purpose-driven elements. Every part is designed to intentionally help teens grow closer to their friends, their leaders, and most importantly, Jesus. And each component is created with every teen in mind—from the one who's grown up in church to the first-time visitor.

### *GAMES*

It might look like we're just having a good time, but our games are way more than that. They have two main purposes:

1. Build connections – Games help students break down walls and get to know each other.
2. Build trust – Having fun together creates relationships where teens feel safe to ask questions and explore faith.

And yes—games are just plain fun too!



## *LESSON*

Each week, we dive into a 10–15 minute lesson that’s relevant, creative, and completely rooted in the Bible. Our goal is to meet every student where they are and share Biblical truths that actually transform lives.

## *LIFE GROUPS*

Our life groups are all about doing life together. This isn’t just a small group where we recap the lesson and ask a few questions. Instead, these groups are a place to encourage one another, pray, listen, point each other back to God, wrestle with tough topics, and navigate whatever life throws our way. Life groups shift the focus from simply answering questions to building a Christ-centered community.

## *CONNECTION TIMES*

Some of the best conversations happen when you’re just hanging out—sitting on a couch, playing Uno, a video game, or grabbing a snack. That’s why each week we set aside connection time, a kind of “free time” where students can play games, relax on the couches, or enjoy a card game. This time helps students build friendships with one another, and it gives our leaders a chance to connect personally with each teen and have meaningful conversations.

# THE FINE PRINT

## SAFETY GUIDELINES

Your teenager's safety is a top priority for our ministry, and we want to keep you informed about how we care for and protect them.

### **WE SCREEN VOLUNTEERS**

Before serving with us, every volunteer completes a thorough application and interview process, including a criminal background check.

### **WE TRAIN VOLUNTEERS**

We train our volunteers to make sure they have everything they need to serve students well. Leaders participate in regular training throughout the year and are required to complete our online training, which can be found here: [montclair.church/course/youth-ministry-training/](https://montclair.church/course/youth-ministry-training/)

### **WE SET BOUNDARIES**

Our youth ministry staff and volunteers follow clear guidelines to keep your teen safe. You can help by supporting these boundaries:

- No leader will meet one-on-one with a teen without your knowledge and consent.
- No leader will transport a teen alone; another adult or teen will always accompany them.
- All staff and volunteers maintain appropriate physical boundaries with teens at all times.



# WE REPORT DANGEROUS SITUATIONS

Every staff member and volunteer in our ministry is a mandated reporter. This means we are legally required to immediately report any dangerous or potentially dangerous situations, including:

- If a student is being harmed, neglected, or abused
- If a student is harming or abusing someone else
- If a student is harming or at risk of harming themselves
